

Job Vacancy

The Department of English and Linguistics, Faculty of Liberal Arts, Thammasat University, Thailand, currently has one teaching position (Specialist II position) available.

We invite applications from native speakers of English who hold a PhD in Linguistics or a closely related field. An experience teaching and/or conducting research on the interface between psycholinguistics and issues having to do with cognition, mind and language processing is preferred.

The employment agreement is renewable on a yearly basis for the first two years. After this period, depending on job performance, the contract may be renewed every two years, with a possible pay rise. Application screening involves document check-up, followed by a face-to-face or an on-line interview (arranged at the applicant's own expense).

The successful candidate will teach up to two or three courses per semester, producing at least one publication per year and providing administrative assistance, such as serving in varying boards of examiners and the editorial team of our *Journal of Language and Linguistics*, language editing, organising academic seminars and conferences, etc. The starting rate of remuneration is 46,770 baht per month (i.e. 33,770 baht of actual salary, plus a housing allowance of 8,000 baht and a further financial supplement of 5,000 baht per month).

Please note that:

- Prospective applicants are expected to show that they have good interpersonal and cross-cultural communication skills, an ability to work both individually and in a team, and most importantly, familiarity with a Thai work setting.
- Your application will only be finalised on condition that we receive an evidence of your graduation verification directly from your university's Registrar. We need this proof for all degrees that you hold.

4. Copies of all transcripts and degree diplomas
5. Copies of sample work
